Delivery Requirements

ADM Locations are Subject to Change

- 1 Must grow Edible Beans for ADM
- 2 Must deliver Edible Beans to a qualified ADM location
- 3 Must deliver Edible Beans during the respective crop year (2026 or 2027, based on Program Enrollment Year)

Qualifying Delivery Locations:

- Auburn, MI
- Kinde, MI
- Reese, MI
- Pinconning, MI
- Ubly, MI

Cover Crop Incentives

Payments are made per-acre, up to the number of edible bean acres harvested in the respective program year

2026 Program

CC Planted in 2025

\$5/acre

- Plant CC by regional NRCS date
- Edible Beans must be in rotation on the farm
- Acres also in federally funded programs (EQIP/CSP) are eligible

No incentives are available for acres in another privately funded program

2027 Program

CC Planted in 2026

\$10/acre

\$20/acre

- \$20/acre rate applies to acres not in any other program

How It Works

1. Submit Information

You work with Gradable to upload field/program information.

2. Acres Are Verified

Gradable uses satellite imagery & data analysis to determine which acres qualify for payments.

3. Eligibility Is Confirmed

Eligible acres are reviewed and verified based on program requirements.

4. Payment is Sent

ADM sends payment based on qualifications.

- A small subset of farmers will be selected for an on-site interview and compensated \$1,000.
- Acres enrolled in another program receiving private funding are not eligible for incentives.

Field boundaries must be submitted to Gradable for all acres. If any acres are participating in another privately and/or publicly funded carbon or sustainability program, those acres must be clearly identified to determine incentive eligibility under the ADM re:generations program.
