Delivery Requirement

You must deliver peanuts to a Golden Peanut facility or another delivery point approved by Golden Peanut.

Peanut Incentives

Payments are made per-acre, up to the number of peanut acres harvested in the respective program year

Irrigation Optimization	\$2/acre - Applies to irrigated peanut acres - Must use an irrigation scheduling tool/technology to manage water applications (Example: Irrigator Pro app) - Must provide a report with field data summary from your scheduling tool	\$2/acre
Reduced Till	\$2/acre - Must use Reduced Till practices such as chisel plowing, field cultivating, tandem disking, vertical tillage, or ridge tillage on peanut acres - T-DISC Score ≤ 0.252 - Primary inversion tillage <u>does not</u> qualify - Residue must <u>not</u> be burned	\$2/acre

How It Works

1. Submit Information

You work with Gradable to upload field/program information.

2. Acres Are Verified

Gradable uses satellite imagery & data analysis to determine which acres qualify for payments.

3. Eligibility Is Confirmed

Eligible acres are reviewed and verified based on program requirements.

4. Payment is Sent

ADM sends payment based on qualifications.

- A small subset of farmers will be selected for an on-site interview and compensated \$1,000.
- Acres enrolled in another program receiving private funding are not eligible for incentives.

Data Collection Partner



Field boundaries must be submitted to Gradable for all peanut acres. If any acres are participating in another privately and/or publicly funded carbon or sustainability program, those acres must be clearly identified to determine incentive eligibility under the ADM re:generations program.
