Delivery Requirement

Delivery to ADM is not required. To qualify for the program, simply report the company or companies where you deliver wheat for the respective program year.

Wheat Incentives

Payments are made per-acre, up to the number of wheat acres harvested in the respective program year

No-Till/Strip Till	\$2/acre No-Till or Strip Till must be the tillage practice implemented on wheat acres	\$2/acre
4R Nitrogen Management	\$5/acre Wheat acres must meet the required criteria for each category: Right Source Right Rate Right Time Right Place	\$5/acre

How It Works

1. Submit Information

You work with Gradable to upload field/program information.

2. Acres Are Verified

Gradable uses satellite imagery & data analysis to determine which acres qualify for payments.

3. Eligibility Is Confirmed

Eligible acres are reviewed and verified based on program requirements.

4. Payment is Sent

ADM sends payment based on qualifications.

- A small subset of farmers will be selected for an on-site interview and compensated \$1,000.
- Acres enrolled in another program receiving private funding are not eligible for incentives.

Data Collection Partner



Field boundaries must be submitted to Gradable for all wheat acres. If any acres are participating in another privately and/or publicly funded carbon or sustainability program, those acres must be clearly identified to determine incentive eligibility under the ADM re:generations program.
